

Day 23 // April 13

Amman, Jordan: Pray for the spread of the gospel and for multiplying house churches among the Palestinian Arab, Najdi Arab, and North Iraqi Arab peoples.

Day 24 // April 14

Cairo, Egypt: Pray for unity among the church, and boldness for Christians from traditional and Orthodox backgrounds in sharing the Good News in this ancient city.

Day 25 // April 15

Khartoum, Sudan: Pray for the establishment of 24/7 prayer and for hearts to be opened for Jesus-followers to hear from heaven.

Day 26 // April 16

Niamey, Niger: Pray for the advancement of God’s Kingdom throughout the city that has a predominantly Muslim population.

Day 27 // April 17 (Night of Power*)

Tashkent, Uzbekistan: Pray for the church to stand strong in Uzbekistan, as the government is seeking to restrict and control the activities of the worshipping community.

Day 28 // April 18

Rabat, Morocco: Pray for the Jesus-followers who are assembling to form training centers to reach their nation for Christ, as many Moroccans are coming to faith.

Day 29 // April 19

Islamabad, Pakistan: Pray for the 4 million orphaned children and 3.5 million Afghan refugees who are now living in Pakistan.

Day 30 // April 20

Mecca, Saudi Arabia: Pray for the many Saudis that are growing disillusioned with Islam and are coming to Jesus through digital media, traveling abroad, and faithful witness within the nation.

***The Night of Power is on April 17**

During *Laylat al-Qadr*, the “Night of Power,” Muslims are seeking Allah with intense focus. Pray that God will miraculously reveal himself to them in dreams and visions.

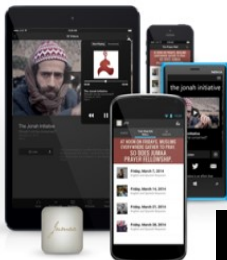

Day 1 // March 22

Beirut, Lebanon: Pray for a move of God to bring hope and peace to break through the violence and destruction that has brought this nation to a failed state.

Day 2 // March 23

Muscat, Oman: Pray for the Christ-exalting, multiplying house churches to multiply throughout all 29 languages spoken in Muscat, especially among the Omani Arabs and Bedouin Arabs.

Day 3 // March 24

Baku, Azerbaijan: Pray for Scripture-based revelation over the underground house churches as they send teams in the 22 languages in the capital city of Baku.

Day 4 // March 25

Almaty, Kazakhstan: Pray for a mighty movement of prayer to be birthed in Almaty that multiplies throughout this Central Asian country.

Day 5 // March 26

Kazan, Russia: Pray for the hour of deliverance for God's children to be set free from the communistic ideology through the truth of the Gospel.

Day 6 // March 27

Tehran, Iran: Pray for the awakening and strengthening of believers who have been in hiding, and for them to have boldness in sharing their faith in this populous city.

Day 7 // March 28

Dar es Salaam, Tanzania: Dar es Salaam means "Abode of Peace". Pray for a mighty movement of prayer for God's peace to saturate the city and spread throughout the nation of Tanzania.

Day 8 // March 29

Algiers, Algeria: Pray for the New Testament translation that is happening in the Chenua language that is spoken in Algiers.

Day 9 // March 30

Mogadishu, Somalia: Pray for the Somali church that is growing and that Jesus-followers will be bold in sharing their faith with the people.

Day 10 // March 31

Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan: Pray for the followers of Jesus to walk in the power of the Spirit as they face increased persecution in this country.

Day 11 // April 1

Dubai, UAE: Pray for a mighty movement of prayer to be birthed in Dubai that multiplies throughout the country.

**Day 12 // April 2**

Kabul, Afghanistan: Pray for the Kingdom of God to come in signs, wonders, and power as the church in Afghanistan is the second fastest-growing church in the world.

Day 13 // April 3

Jerusalem, Israel: Pray for unity among Jews and Arabs as they launch Christ-exalting, multiplying house churches among the various people groups and 39 languages represented in Jerusalem.

Day 14 // April 4

Baghdad, Iraq: Pray for the window of opportunity that is opening for Jesus-followers in

Iraq to heal their fractured nation through the peace of God found only in the Messiah.

Day 15 // April 5

Medina, Saudi Arabia: Pray for the Saudi church to stand in opposition to Muhammad's declaration of 1,400 years ago, and to capitalize on greater freedom and claiming their country for the King of Kings.

Day 16 // April 6

Sana'a, Yemen: Pray that the Lord would have mercy on the city and bring an end to the civil war wracking the nation of Yemen.

Day 17 // April 7

Djibouti, Djibouti: Pray for the advancement of God's Kingdom throughout the four largest ethnic majorities in this nation—Somali, Afar, Omani, and Yemeni.

Day 18 // April 8

Damascus, Syria: Pray for refugees, the poor, and the broken to find hope and healing in Jesus' name.

Day 19 // April 9

Mosul, Iraq: Pray for the teams who have dedicated their lives to planting churches and sharing the gospel in this nation; pray for their supernatural protection and for wisdom and courage.

Day 20 // April 10

Tripoli, Libya: Pray for Tripoli to be a sending place, impacting the entire nation and region with the delivering power of Jesus.

Day 21 // April 11

Tunis, Tunisia: Pray for the Christians of Tunisia to be able to stand strong in proclaiming the victory of Jesus that will bring true and lasting liberation to their land.

Day 22 // April 12

Addis Ababa, Ethiopia: Because of its location in the Horn of Africa, pray that Ethiopia would be a sending nation to its many unreached tribes and neighboring nations with the gospel of Jesus.
