

PRAY FOR AFRICA

NIGERIA

According to Open Doors, more Christians are killed for their faith in Nigeria than anywhere else in the world! Between 2022-2024, 9,814 Nigerian Christians were killed. Nigeria also tops the list for abductions and assaults, with 9,311 recorded incidents. This violence comes from Islamic extremist groups such as Boko Haram, Fulanii herdsmen, and the Islamic State's West Africa Province. The attacks are brutal. Many believers are killed, others are kidnapped while women are sexually assaulted. They violently destroy homes and churches. In turn, the people flee and live in displacement camps. The Democratic Repuclic of the Congo, Mozambique, and Ethiopia are the other African nations ranked high for killing Christians.

SUDAN

Sudan is the nation with the world's largest dispacement and hunger crisis! Approximately 10 million people are currently displaced out of the nations' total population of 49.4 million--that's approximately 1/5 of the nations' population! In 2025, Sudan is facing systemic persecution and atrocities that target specific ethnic groups and Christians. These all point to a situation where persecution is structural, not just incidental.

SOMALIA

In Somalia, following Jesus is a matter of life and death! A violent Islamic militant group controls large areas of the country. They enforce Sharia law and are committed to eradicating Christianity from Somalia. Even within a persons' own family, suspicion of conversion to Christianity could result in house arrest, forced marriage, or other threats from one's own family! Second only to North Korea, Somalia is a very dangerous place for Christians. There are only a few hundred Christians in the nation.
